# **SSU OFFERS TWO SEPARATE – BUT COORDINATED- Programs in the Masters of Education**



The purpose of the Teacher Education Program is to prepare educators to be learner-centered and inquiring professionals who can think critically, act ethically, communicate effectively, and work collaboratively to meet the diverse needs of all students. By encouraging the acquisition of these characteristics, this program hopes to develop educational professionals who will be change agents in their schools and communities through the implementation of evidence-based teaching practices and the demonstration of strong, yet collaborative, leadership qualities.

## Master of Science in Curriculum and Instruction

The M.Ed. in Curriculum & Instruction is professional designed the meet development needs of teachers by providing them with an advanced professional degree that will enhance their teaching knowledge, skills, experiences and dispositions. The curriculum is organized to achieve this goal through a graduate education core, a capstone (research) core and Curriculum & Instruction strand with courses providing new and updated information in curriculum and instruction—a central aspect of the teaching profession. Students will have the option of individualizing their final research project to better suit their own

needs by selecting either the preparation of a National Board for Professional Teaching Standards portfolio or by completing an applied research project in an approved, related topic area.

## Master of Science in Intervention Specialist

Special education professionals are committed to developing the highest educational and quality of life potential of individuals with exceptionalities. To that end, the Intervention Specialist programs at Shawnee State prepare teacher candidates to meet the needs of those individuals with exceptionalities by providing a quality program that meets the high standards set by the Council for Exceptional Children, the Ohio Department of Education, and the SSU School of Education five domains of teacher capacity. This program is designed to help expand the credentials of the already-licensed teacher. Individuals who hold a baccalaureate degree and are seeking an initial teaching license, may work with a faculty advisor to develop a program completion plan that will meet their needs. In order to earn an initial teaching license, course work and extensive, supervised field and clinical experiences are required beyond those included in the graduate level program.
